Children Welfare & Protection Program

Offering nutritious meals, school supplies, tutoring, and mentoring to vulnerable children to promote their growth and development, along side orphanage outreaches

Women Empowerment

Outreach programs to raise awareness about gender equality, domestic violence, and access to social services. Also, training workshops for women and widows

Community Empowerment Outreach

Skill training, awareness campaigns, and support groups aimed at empowering vulnerable populations to improve their social and economic wellbeing

Prisoner Support Program

Providing legal counsel, rights education, and advocacy for prisoners who have not received fair justice, helping to ensure their protection and reintegration into society

Outreach & Identification

Assessment & Intake

Once contact is established, we conduct a personalized needs assessment to understand each person's unique circumstances

Tailored Support Planning

Based on the assessment, we develop an individualized support plan like Job Training, Education, or Life-Skills Development

Service Delivery & Coordination

We regularly follow-up to track progress, celebrate successes, and adjust services as needed
